- First lessons on one of the following: brass, woodwind, percussion and strings.

Day 2:

- Continuing lessons on instruments
- Working your skills into a composition with Phil Mullen
- Behaviour management
- Child Protection, Equal Opportunities issues
- Plenary: Musitrax issues, logistics and planning lessons
- Performance of the composition
